





Possenti, the official coach of Open Water for the Brazilian Olympic Committee with 20 years of experience coaching elite athletes, has earned 14 medals in World Championship competitions, including six gold, two silver, and six bronze, across multiple years, solidifying his reputation as one of the world's premier open water coaches.

Fernando Possenti has succeeded as an open water coach, guiding his athletes to Olympic Gold and receiving the esteemed World Aquatics Coaching Achievement Award consecutively from 2014 to 2021.

Possenti's coaching prowess is exemplified by his work with Ana Marcela Cunha, who, under his tutelage, secured five World Champion titles and an Olympic Gold medal in the 10k Marathon swim at the Tokyo Olympics. With over two decades of coaching experience, he currently serves as the official coach of Open Water for the Brazilian Olympic Committee, fostering elite athletes who represent Brazil on the Olympic stage.

Throughout World Championship competitions, Possenti's athletes have consistently excelled, accumulating an impressive tally of 14 medals, including six gold, two silver, and six bronze, across multiple years such as 2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, 2022, and 2023.

Possenti's profound impact on Brazilian sports was officially recognised with his election as the best coach in Brazil across all sports disciplines in 2018 and 2021. Before his coaching career, he enjoyed a successful tenure as a swimmer, claiming titles as the Brazilian and South American champion in the 200m Individual Medley and butterfly disciplines and setting Brazilian national records. Fernando Possenti continues to inspire and shape the future of open water swimming through his exceptional coaching and dedication to athletic excellence.
